CROSS COUNTRY CHAMPIONSHIPS  
FRIDAY, OCTOBER 27, 2017

Location:

Cross Roads Park, Gilbert, Arizona. Cross Roads park is located at Greenfield Road and Knox between Ray and Warner Road.

Directions:

From Tucson: Take I-10 to loop 202 east bound. Exit at San Tan Village Road and turn left (heading north-west) Travel approximately 2.5. Park entrance will be on your left, at the light for Knox road.

From Phoenix: Take the Superstition (US60) Freeway east bound. Exit Greenfield Road and turn right (heading south). Head south approximately 3 miles. Park entrance will be on your right, at the light for Knox Road.

Time Schedule: (A rotation is set for every year- last division set becomes the first race set the following year, third set becomes the last set etc)

### Awards:

Medals will be awarded to the top fourteen (14) individuals in each sectional race.  
The top team will receive a Sectional Championship Plaque.

### Awards Schedule:

Awards for Division 2 will begin at approximately 10:45 am  
Awards for Division 3 will begin at approximately 11:45 am  
Awards for Division 1 will begin at approximately 1:30 pm  
Awards for Division 4 will begin at approximately 2:30 pm

### Course:

The course is grass, granite, dirt and some concrete and asphalt. Copy of the map is online at [www.aiaonline.org](http://www.aiaonline.org) under coaches→Cross Country. Make copies of the map as there will be none at the coaches meeting or in the coaches packet. **NO SPIKES are allowed to be worn. NOR are bikes allowed to be ridden by coaches or those affiliated with a team.**

### Section Entry Procedure:

Each team must designate up to seven runners. Entries are to be submitted online at [www.athletic.net](http://www.athletic.net)

Entry deadline is Monday, October 23 by 12:00 PM. Changes to your entries will be allowed at check in. Coaches need to add this meet to your meet calendar on athletic.net.

If you Do NOT have an athletic.net account you need to allow several days for your account to be set and activated.

### State Qualification:

The top 25 individuals (25) will advance to state. Only the top 50% of full teams entered by entry deadline will qualify for state. This number will be told at the coaches meeting and will be in your coaches' packet. If there is an odd number of scoring teams, then one additional team (even number) will advance to state.

All entries for the AIA State Cross Country championships are to be made online at [www.athletic.net](http://www.athletic.net). Deadline for entries is **Monday, October 30, 2017 by 12:00PM (Noon)**.
